

Grade Inflation: Average GPA at Four-Year Institutions





Changes in 4-Year College Grade Distributions Nationwide



Combating Grade Inflation

- Publicizing averages by department
- Including average courses on transcripts
- Targets for professors or department
- Reconsidering role of student evaluations of faculty members



High School Grade Inflation

From 2017 study:

- --Average high school GPA (not weighted) went up from 3.27 to 3.38 from 1998 to 2016.
- --High schools with many black and Latino students did not experience as much grade inflation.
- --At high schools with the most grade inflation, average GPA has hit 3.56.




