# Range of Pandemic Impact

- Some colleges closed, unable to handle the short-term effect.
- Some colleges – generally those that are well off – had huge surpluses.

# The Decision to Return – I

- Space has costs to colleges.
- Many units have performed well remotely.
- Many employees want to work remotely.

# The Decision to Return -- II

- Student reactions to online education were (by most surveys) negative. But the online education the students first received was not (by anyone's standards) good online education.
